West Ridge Childcare Centre Sick Policy (COVID-19) – Updated August 25th 2020

- Staff, children, and families are required to stay home and not enter the building if they or a family member:
 - Are experiencing acute respiratory or flu-like symptoms including fever, sore throat, cough, or difficulty breathing
 - Have been advised to self-isolate by a physician or the HealthLine 811
- Staff, children, and families can return to the Centre once they are asymptomatic (no symptoms of any kind) for a period of 48 consecutive hours.
- Staff, children, and families will self-monitor for any symptoms of illness daily. If symptoms are present, even if they are mild, you must self-isolate immediately and contact 811 for further direction.
- Mandatory self-isolation for 14 days is required for anyone returning from outside Canada but not for travel within Canada. For people travelling within Canada, they should self-monitor for 14 days.
- Proper hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette are mandatory for anyone entering our facility.
- Non-essential visitors are not permitted into the Centre at this time. Any essential visitors (i.e.
 inspectors, referring professionals, maintenance, or repair persons) will be required to wear a
 mask while in the facility.
